The Pauahi Keiki Scholars Kindergarten (PKS-K) Program at a Glance

The Program

The Pauahi Keiki Scholars Kindergarten (PKS-K) Program provides need-based tuition assistance to kindergarteners attending **participating accredited** non-Kamehameha private schools **in Hawaii**.

Who can apply for school year 2009-2010

To be eligible for the scholarship, a child must be accepted to a participating private school **in Hawaii**.

Scholarship amount

Scholarship amounts are determined using a sliding scale based on the school's tuition and the estimated amount each family is able to contribute. In 2008-2009 the scholarship cap was \$6,000 per student. The 2009-2010 scholarship cap has not yet been set. Families are required to apply at the participating school's financial aid program. The tuition balance (what is not funded by KS or the participating school) is paid for by the child's family.

How to apply for school year 2009-2010

- Complete a Kamehameha Schools <u>PKS-Kindergarten (PKS-K) scholarship application form</u> at the same time as applying to the <u>private school admissions</u>. Kamehameha Schools PKS-Kindergarten (PKS-K) scholarship applications will be available in <u>January 2009</u>. In addition, <u>signed copies</u> of your 2008 tax documents and 2008 W-2/1099 statements are needed to complete the application process.
- Complete a <u>School and Student Services Parents' Financial Statement form</u> for school year 2009-2010 online at <u>www.nais.org</u>. Be sure to input Kamehameha Schools' school code, 2930. This form determines your estimated family contribution or your ability to pay for your child's education. Paper forms are available at Kamehameha Schools Applicant Service Center in January 2009. Any applications posted marked or received after the deadline date will not be eligible for financial aid &/or scholarship consideration.
- Mail your PKS-K school year 2009-2010 application and 2008 tax forms to Kamehameha Schools (KS), and submit your 2009-2010 Parents' Financial Statement form online or by mail.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: FEBRUARY 28, 2009

PKS-K applications must be postmarked and mailed no later than **FEBRUARY 28**, **2009**. Mail to:
